Medicare Part D: Prescription Drug Benefit Plan

Enrollment for the Medicare Prescription Drug Plans begins Nov. 15, 2005 and ends May 15, 2006. If someone enrolls by Dec 31, 2005, the new Medicare Prescription Drug coverage will begin on Jan 1, 2006. Enrolling after Dec 31, 2005 will delay the coverage effective date. Postponing enrollment after May 15, 2006, may result in a 1% per month penalty for every month you delayed enrollment. The Prescription Drug plan will be sold by private companies whose plans have been approved by Medicare. You can identify an approved plan by the MedicareRx logo. 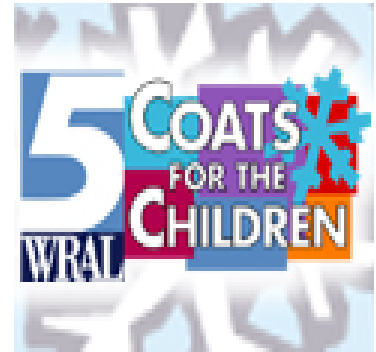


Brothers of Iota Iota Chapter Volunteer to Man Phone Bank for the Coats for the Children Telethon on Friday Dec. 9, 2005
